## Access to the Internet pages:

Our information pages are provided exclusively on the central web servers of the data center and the web servers of the FIT (Freiburg Center for Interactive Materials and Bioinspired Technologies).

Each of your accesses to the website of the University of Freiburg is stored in a log file. The data in the log file is not personalized. Therefore, we do not know which pages or files you have accessed.

The following data is stored in the log file:

- Name of the retrieved file
- Date and time of the call
- Message if the retrieval was successful
- IP address

The stored data will only be evaluated to optimize the website. There is no transfer to third parties, either for commercial or non-commercial purposes.

#### Security:

Our website uses cookies. Cookies are text files stored on the user's computer system by the internet browser. When a user visits a website, a cookie can be stored on the user's computer system. This cookie includes a distinctive sequence of characters that enables a clear identification of the browser the next time the user visits the website.

The following data are stored in cookies and sent to the user's computer system by this website:
